Position Description

The ideal candidate will be a creative, passionate, and experienced soccer coach who inspires students and thrives in a collaborative atmosphere. The ideal candidate has a communicative approach to coaching and designs practices and drills that integrate skill proficiency, teamwork and an equitable balance of time between all players. The candidate sparks a love for soccer in their coaching and provides opportunities to strengthen students' on-the-field skills. The ideal candidate brings excitement to the field and celebrates player achievement at all levels. Candidates with coaching experience preferred.

In addition, all coaches will be expected to lead all practices, attend and coach all games, be available to drive the van for away matches, work with girls to improve skills and providing a positive, active and healthy experience for our girls. Practices for JV are held five days per week after school with approximately two games per week, depending on availability and post-season championships. Coaches will be expected to attend the pre-season coaches meeting, as well as post-season awards ceremony.

This candidate will be expected to work with Athletic Director regularly, communicate with parents and students regarding sport and any events and/or issues that may arise and comply with all IAAM policies, rules & regulations.

Candidate must have excellent communication, organizational and interpersonal skills. Knowledge of soccer is required, with IAAM experience being preferred. Bachelor's degree also preferred. This is a paid position.
